

The Oregon Game Project Challenge (OGPC) is an annual STEAM-focused game development competition for high school and middle school students. We aim to inspire the next generation to develop skills in areas including programming, project management, art/design, and marketing, while working as a team on a long term project.

Every year since 2008, we have brought students from across Oregon and southern Washington together to show off the games they have developed and to interact with industry professionals. In 2022, a year still affected by the pandemic, 164 students on 40 teams representing 19 different schools participated in OGPC. In 2023, we expect ~250 students to participate.

OGPC is organized and run by a 501(c)(3) of the same name. We run a lean, all-volunteer operation. Our annual budget is under ~\$17,500 and covers competition-day expenses such as the facility rental fee, insurance, trophies and t-shirts for participants, and lunch for our volunteer judges.
